## CONNECTING TO THE INTERNET

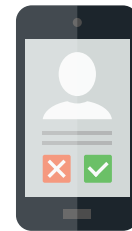
Whether you are using your laptop or cell phone, connecting to the Internet is a snap. Simply:

- Open your available network connections
- Select the ship's Wi-Fi network
- Open a web browser and follow the instructions to connect



## CALLING FROM YOUR CELL PHONE

While different carriers have various roaming charges, you can still use your cell phone while at sea. Call your cell phone provider prior to leaving to see if there are optional packages for cruisers! Some cruise lines offer specific calling apps with interesting packages - check the cruise line's website or call your travel agent to get more info.



## CRUISE AMENITIES

Each cabin is usually equipped with its own phone. Additional phone charges will apply, so check with your cruise line. If you forget your laptop and want to connect, most cruise lines have an Internet café where you can log in and pay by the minute or with a package.



## APPLICATIONS

Check to see if your cruise has an app that you can download before you leave. Many times you can see upcoming itineraries, amenities and much more!
